#### 5,205 MEALS SERVED

This is a significant increase over 2022 (4,708 meals served).



#### 21 UNIQUE VOLUNTEER GROUPS SERVED MEALS

Each group brought 6-12 individual volunteers.



#### **78 GUESTS SHELTERED**

The Severe Weather Shelter filled 78 beds over 10 nights. This also was a dramatic increase over 2022.

ReFuel was once again the grateful recipient of a grant from the Camas -Washougal Community Chest, in partnership with Camas Rotary

Funds were used for bus passes and rain coats for those in need, and to help with the endless cost of paper products used in our kitchen.
